Our students consistently achieve outstanding results, and many have gone on to study at the most prestigious universities in the UK including Oxford, Cambridge, Manchester, and Central St Martins. In one year alone four of our sixth formers went on to study medicine.

We are a community with shared values rooted in our faith, and we work closely with parents and a range of partners to enable our students to become confident, caring and successful young women. A RICH HERITAGE

St Saviour's & St Olave's School has a long tradition of providing a high quality education for girls from this community, and can trace its history back through four centuries to the time of Queen Elizabeth I.

The school's long association with the parish of St Saviour, Southwark, is remembered each year in March when we gather in Southwark Cathedral for the annual service of Commemoration and Thanksgiving.

Today, St Saviour's & St Olave's is a Voluntary Aided Comprehensive School and Sixth Form Centre, providing a high quality modern education for girls from II to 18.

The school is proud to have a wide range of modern facilities for its students. As well as purpose-built classrooms, equipped with the latest interactive teaching and learning technology, we also have a specialist Drama Studio, a Music Suite and a Recording Studio; a large Sports Hall for P.E. as well as our own playing fields in Greendale, Dulwich; and our own School Chapel and Chaplain.

AIMING HIGH

We pride ourselves in providing a curriculum which meets the individual needs of all our students whether they progress to Oxbridge or follow a vocational route.

We ensure that there is rigour at whatever level or stage the student is at. Most of our students progress through to our Sixth Form and, along with students from other schools in the local community, study a wide range of courses (vocational, AS and A Level) with the majority continuing into Higher Education at universities across the UK.

We are a Science Specialist College and see a large number of Sixth Form students each year taking A Level Physics, Chemistry and Biology. Higher Education offers are made to study science-related courses such as Medicine, Pharmacology and Dentistry at some of the country's most prestigious universities including Oxford, Cambridge, King's and Imperial College, London.
